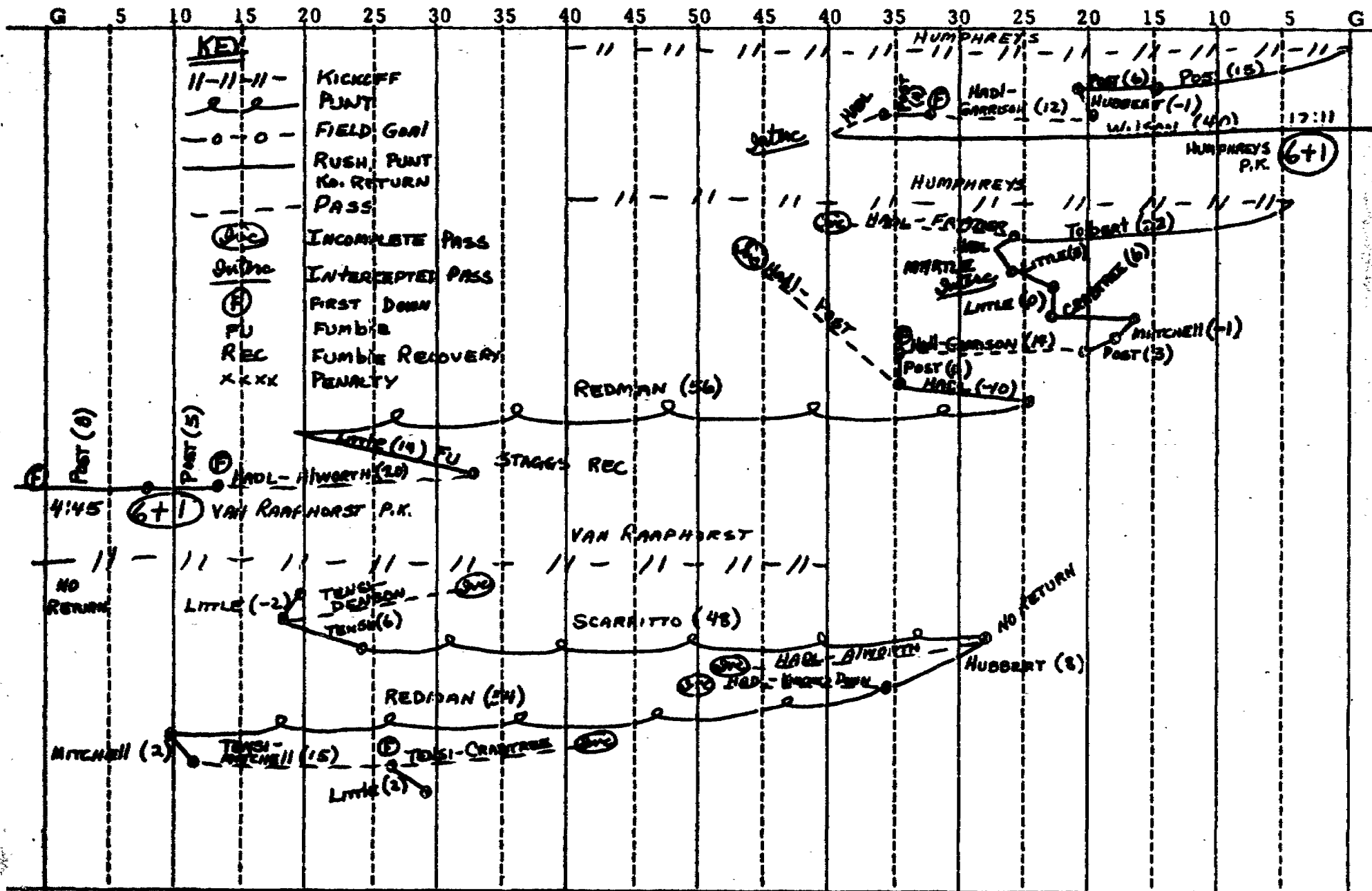

SID GILLMAN----When asked who would get game ball, Gillman said "we didn't get the ball that blonde in the stands got it."
