#### **RUNNING BACK DE'ANGELO HENDERSON**

##### **On his fiancée's reaction to his car accident**

"As soon as I was able to find somebody with a cell phone—because I lost mine, my phone flew—I called her off of a number she didn't know so she didn't answer the first time. When she answered, she was flustered. When she tried to come out, she went the total wrong way. Because we live off of Lincoln and Jordan, and she went the opposite direction. She was all in tears. She didn't believe me at first. She thought I was pranking her. I was like 'No, this is real. Like I just got into an accident. Come here' But she's OK, she's strong."

##### **On how he felt about losing his jeep in the accident**

"I had my jeep for a year, like it had tinted windows, good system on the inside—all of that good stuff. The way the jeep protected me, I'm going to stick with a jeep. I probably won't get a Wrangler. I'll probably get more of a family car now. Like a Jeep Cherokee or something like that, the Grand Cherokee. I loved my Jeep. Every time we pass one I'm like 'Dang, I miss my jeep.'"

##### **On being back on the field a week after the car accident**

"It definitely makes you appreciate everything more. After I stopped, I was like 'I'm lucky.' I've got a newborn son, I got a fiancée, I've got a family that really cares about me and teammates that are counting on me this year. It definitely put everything into perspective. It humbled you down a little bit more and made you appreciate life. It's not just football, it's life. It's just a blessing to be here after going through something like that. A lot of people wouldn't have survived that. I had some people up in the sky protecting me throughout that accident for sure."

##### **On Panthers RB C.J. Anderson' being released**

"It was devastating because he taught me so much. But at the same time, it's a business and it's next man up. Now he's gone. It's a good competition to see which guy is going to get number one or number two. Everybody's fighting right now just to get on the field. Me personally, I just want to get on the field this year. Whatever role I got to have, that's what I'm going to have."

##### **On being the second-most tenured running back on the team**

"It is weird that the oldest year in the room is a year three guy (RB Devontae Booker). I think he's well prepared for the role he's going to have this year. I think I'm well prepared, and I'm getting more prepared for the role I'm going to have. The young guys are doing the same. They're going to be prepared as well."

##### **On QB Case Keenum**

"You can definitely see a difference. He's real confident in himself. He's not like a loud, rude guy. He's calmer. He'll point here or there like, 'Hey guys, chill, let's have some fun.' He's that kind of guy. He's definitely a leader. You can tell that from Day 1 how he's on the field."
