##### **On how much of the mental aspects of the game is he focusing on**

“In the classroom it’s very mental. But most of it, you just have to come here and play. Sometimes you’re going to mess up, you’ve got to get over it and go to the next play. You’re still learning each and every day, putting in new things each and every day. So, you’ve just got to learn every day, every time.”

##### **On moving on after mistakes occur**

“It’s practice. You have to try to do your best to go to the next play because the next play is coming like that (snaps fingers). It’s not like a game where you can be in or be out. But it’s not that hard, you just got to have a rapid mindset like, ‘I’ve got to do the next play.’ So, the last play is out of my mind. The next day I recover from it and come back to do your job.”
