FULLBACK ANDY JANOVICH

On the change in the offense with Offensive Coordinator Bill Musgrave

“I think he’s changed quite a bit but at the same time, he hasn’t. We have a lot of the same runs, passes and whatnot. A little bit of different terminology but he didn’t override anything. It’s still football.”

On the need to be more consistent on special teams

“Yeah, last year was rough. But I think we’re going to have a great year with [Special Teams Coordinator Tom] McMahon. Just looking at what he’s done with the Colts, he’s been top-five the last three or four years. I think he’s going to turn this thing around for us. I miss [former Special Teams Coordinator] Brock [Olivo], but it’s on to the next.”

On his offseason training

“We got [Head Strength and Conditioning Coach Loren] Landow in there. He’s going to be awesome. I feel like I’m getting really strong again. He’s got us kind of like old Nebraska work out sessions. We’re lifting heavy weights again and he’s got us doing a lot of running and all of this different type of stuff for speed. It’s just like being in Nebraska. I’m excited.”

On if switching coaches and coordinators has an effect on him as a fullback

“Yeah, you never know with my position. There are only 20-21 of us or something like that. So, you just never know what’s going to happen. It’s a tough position to play. Not everybody uses them, but the teams that do use them tend to use them [a lot]. I feel like I’m getting used this year. You just never know. I hope so.”

On the young players in the running backs room

“They really are understanding the game a lot faster than I would have expected. When I came in, I feel it took a while. But they’re really hands-on with it. They’re understanding the pass protection, the run game and different route concepts. I’m really excited about it.”
