DEFENSIVE END DEREK WOLFE

On how afraid he was after his injury

"It was scary. I thought I was going to lose the use of my right arm. It was really scary. But we had to do all kinds of research and figure out what the best treatment would be to keep me playing. I talked to one doctor and he said that it was probably the best idea not to play."

On if he ever thought about quitting football due to his injury

"No. I don't ever think that way. This is my life. Do you ever think is it worth it getting up and coming out here and asking me questions? Do you ever think of that? No, I never really think, 'Oh it's not worth it.' To me it's always worth it. It's not just the money, but I love doing what I do. What other job can you work where you get paid this kind of money?"

On whether he is worried about reinjuring his neck

"I'm not worried about it. Up front the pads make it a little bit easier. Right now, we don't have any pads on and we're going [hard]. So, when you get the pads on, it actually cushions the blow a little bit. If you can withstand this stuff, then you will be fine."

On this defensive line being better than 2015

"I mean what were we? Top 3 against the run last year? And I only played 12 games. I'm not saying that I'm the main factor in that. But imagine if we had stayed healthy the whole season. How good we can really be? When we shut down the run, we've got to get some sacks obviously. But that stuff is going to come. If you shut down the run and you score some points on offense, the sacks will come. They've proven that in situations where they have to pass. It's not just that quick, grab the ball and throw it. Make their quarterback have to hold it for a little bit. But we'll get there."
