High School: Was a two-way lineman for Leilehua HS, playing both left tackle and left guard on offense, while appearing as nose guard and end on defense ... earned second-team ScoringLive all-Hawaii Division I honors as an offensive lineman and second-team American Family Insurance ALL-USA Hawai'i honors as a defensive lineman, as well as first-team all-O'ahu Interscholastic Association (OIA) Red honors as a defensive lineman and second-team accolades as an offensive lineman.
