Coaches Appreciation Award, defense . . . **2019** - - Started all 12 games in which he played, missing one game due to injury . . . recorded 52 tackles with 41 solo stops and 11 assists . . . also had three interceptions, nine pass break-ups and one recovered fumble . . . started at cornerback in 38-14 win over Miami as defense allowed just 59 net rushing yards . . . recorded only interception of the game and had 14 yard return, to go with one pass break-up, two solo tackles and one assisted tackle . . . started at cornerback in 30-0 win over Rutgers as defense allowed just 125 yards total offense . . . recorded one pass interception and one pass break-up vs. Rutgers . . . started at cornerback in 18-17 win at Iowa State . . . recorded five solo tackles at Iowa State . . . started at cornerback in 48-3 win over Middle Tennessee as defense allowed just 216 yards total offense . . . seven tackles vs. MTSU, including six solo stops and one assist . . . started at cornerback in 10-3 loss at #18 Michigan . . . recorded three tackles at Michigan, including one solo tackle and two assists, along with one pass break-up . . . started at defensive back in 17-12 loss to #9 Penn State . . . four tackles vs. PSU, including one solo stop and three assists . . . started at cornerback in 26-20 win over Purdue as defense allowed just 33 net rushing yards . . . recorded three tackles vs. Purdue, including one solo stop and two assists, along with one pass break-up . . . started at cornerback in 20-0 win at Northwestern as defense allowed just 64 net rushing yards and 202 yards total offense . . . three tackles at Northwestern, including two solo stops and one assist, along with two pass break-ups . . . started at cornerback in 24-22 loss at #16 Wisconsin . . . career-best seven solo tackles at Wisconsin . . . did not see action in 23-19 win over #7 Minnesota due to injury . . . started at cornerback in 19-10 win over Illinois . . . matched career-best with eight solo tackles vs. Illinois, along with team-leading third interception of the season . . . started at cornerback in 27-24 win at Nebraska . . . recorded four tackles at Nebraska, including three solo stops and one assist, with one tackle for loss and one pass break-up . . . started at cornerback in 49-24 Holiday Bowl win over 22 USC as defense allowed just 22 net rushing yards . . . five solo tackles, two pass break-ups and one fumble recovery vs. USC.

2018 - - Played in all 13 games with seven starts at cornerback . . . recorded 39 tackles, three interceptions for 38 yards and six pass break-ups . . . started at cornerback in 33-7 win over Northern Illinois, recording one assisted tackle as defense allowed just 211 yards total offense . . . started at cornerback in 13-3 win over Iowa State as defense allowed just 19 net rushing yards and 188 yards total offense . . . six tackles vs. ISU, with three solo stops and three assists, to go with one pass break-up . . . started at cornerback in 38-14 win over Northern Iowa as defense allowed just six net rushing yards and 222 yards total offense . . . recorded five tackles vs. UNI, including three solo stops and two assists . . . first career interception vs. UNI, with 29 yard return . . . started at cornerback in 28-17 loss to #18 Wisconsin . . . seven tackles vs. Wisconsin, including three solo stops and four assists, with a shared tackle for loss . . . recorded one solo tackle as defense allowed just 67 net rushing yards in 42-16 win at Indiana . . . started at cornerback in 14-10 loss to Northwestern . . . four tackles vs.

Northwestern, including three solo stops and one assist, along with one pass break-up . . . started at cornerback in 63-0 win at Illinois as defense allowed just 216 yards total offense . . . recorded four tackles at Illinois, including three solo tackles and one assist . . . recorded second interception of the season in second quarter and added career-high two pass break-ups . . . recorded three tackles in 31-28 win over Nebraska, including two solo stops and one assist . . . one pass interception and nine yard return in the fourth quarter for his second theft in two weeks, along with two pass break-ups . . . started at cornerback in 27-22 Outback Bowl win over #18 Mississippi State . . . matched career-high with eight tackles vs. MSU, including five solo stops and three assists.

2017 - - Recorded 29 tackles, including 20 solo stops and nine assists, and one pass break-up . . . started at cornerback in 24-3 win over Wyoming, recording three solo tackles . . . four tackles in 44-41 OT win at Iowa State, with one solo tackle and three assists, along with one pass break-up . . . recorded one solo tackle in 31-14 win over North Texas . . . recorded one solo tackle in 21-19 loss to #4 Penn State . . . started at cornerback in 17-10 loss at Michigan State, recording career-high eight tackles, including four solo tackles and four assists . . . started at cornerback in 45-16 win over Illinois, recording six solo tackles . . . recorded one solo tackle in 17-10 OT loss at Northwestern . . . recorded one assisted tackle in 17-10 win over Minnesota . . . recorded one solo tackle in 55-24 win over #3 Ohio State . . . recorded one assisted tackle in 38-14 loss at #6 Wisconsin . . . recorded one solo tackle in 24-15 loss to Purdue . . . recorded one solo tackle in 27-20 Pinstripe Bowl win over Boston College as defense allowed just 21 net rushing yards and 102 yards total offense in second half.

2016 - - Saw action in all 13 games, recording three solo tackles, two assists and one pass break-up . . . recorded two assisted tackles in 45-21 win over Miami . . . two solo tackles and one pass break-up in 42-3 win over Iowa State . . . recorded one solo tackle in 23-21 loss to North Dakota State.

High school honors - - Named to All-County Dream Team as a senior . . . selected to participate in Border Classic (Michigan vs. Ohio) for Team Michigan . . . **Career** - - Four-year letterman as linebacker and tight end . . . team captain as a senior . . . helped prep team reach state regionals as a junior and semifinals as a senior, posting two-year record of 20-5 . . . led team with 105 tackles as a senior, along with three interceptions . . . recorded 80 tackles as a junior while forcing eight fumbles . . . also lettered in track, competing in hurdle events and earning all-state honors in 110-meter hurdles.
